# REGISTRATIONFORTHE2024/2025ACADEMICSESSION COMMENCES

The registration for the 2024/2025 Academic Session has commenced.

In a statement issued by the Director of ICT of the University, Dr Ebenezer Olajuyigbe, he said " I wish to inform all students that payment for the 2024/2025 Academic Session has commenced on the payment platform for ALL levels".

He added that all levels could proceed for registration of courses after payment except 200 level students. In his words " 200 level students are to please wait patiently for further instruction. Dr Olajuyigbe further said that most of the MBBS and BOS students do not always register, a situation he said would no longer be tolerated by the University.

In his words "While the University is aware of the peculiar nature of study of MBBS and BDS students, ...they are to note that it is compulsory for all students to register henceforth".

### UNIMED 6TH INAUGURAL LECTURE TO EXPLORE WAYS OUT OF THE CAPTIVITY OF MICROBES

The University of Medical Sciences (UNIMED), Ondo is set to host its 6th Inaugural Lecture on the 12th November, 2024 and the lecture will explore ways out of the captivity of microbes.

The Lecture is predicated on the ravaging effects of microbes in air, land and water on human hosts and possible solutions to alleviate the havoc wrecked on the hosts. According to Professor Abdulazeez Abubakar, a Professor of Public Health Microbiology and Parasitology, the Inaugural Lecturer, "I will explore various microbial arsenal for attack and defence as tools for human hostages such as possession of Beta lactamase enzyme, production of Serotoxins, among others".

Overall, the lecture will make useful suggestions and recommendations on the need for governments at all levels to be prepared for more epidemics and pandemics in the nearest future based on the previous experience from the recent COVID-19 pandemic and other emerging diseases such as Ebola and Lassa.

The University of Medical Sciences (UNIMED), Ondo; will host the Global South Arts and Health Week on behalf of Ondo State as part of the Nigerian Pavilion between 21st October and 31st October, 2024.

The Global South Arts and Health Week brings together a slew of emerging and leading interdisciplinary professionals, students. scholars. researchers, academicians, curators, educators, cultural practitioners, diplomats, medical entrepreneurs, health workers, doctors. festival directors, community leaders, development



practitioners, policymakers, technologists, artists, scientists, advocates. activists, administrators, art therapists, musicians, dancers, photographers, and others for strategic partnerships, cultural exchanges, community building, research practice, scientific advancement, skill, and knowledge transfer for regional and global development in Africa, Asia, and Latin America.

Global South Arts & Health Week It has 17 thematic areas which include mental health, good health and well being. climate change and environmental health. neuroscience brain and geriatric health, disability, indigenous language and cultural narratives, among others. It is aimed to advance education. scientific research. and interdisciplinary practice of arts in health, creative art therapy, and communitybased art engagements in the Global South (Africa, Asia, and Latin America) through wide range of а collaborations, community projects, cultural exchanges, exhibitions. workshops, Performances, and Plenary presentations.

According to Dr Ihenacho UNIMED Metuonu, has scheduled two significant programmes for this global event "we have scheduled two significant programmes for this event including a visit to Akure Handicapped Home on Friday, 25th October, 2024 and courtesy call on the Vice-Chancellor on Monday, 28th October, 2024". Also, candidates who did not choose the "Ondo State University of Medical

Sciences" and are willing to change to the Institution as their most preferred (1st)

choice are also advised to apply for the Supplementary Post UTME Screening.

All applicants are required to have a minimum of five (5) credits in either WAEC, NECO or GCEO'L Level, which must include English Language, Mathematics and any other three (3) relevant subjects as may be specified by each Faculty. The five (5) O' Level credits should be obtained in not more than two (2) sittings.

JAMB UTME Subject Combination: All courses in the various Faculties require English Language, Biology, Chemistry and Physics. Candidates applying for admission in Mathematics, Physics, Statistics, or Computer Science are required to present a UTME subject combination of English Language, Mathematics, Physics, and Chemistry.
